

ANTHONY COLES DEPUTY COUNTER FOREIGN INTERFERENCE COORDINATOR DEPARTMENT OF HOME AFFAIRS

Anthony Coles is the Deputy Counter Foreign Interference Coordinator in the Department of Home Affairs. Before taking up this role, between early 2018 and mid-2021 Anthony held senior leadership positions in the Department of Home Affairs with responsibility for policy and legislation relating to law enforcement, transnational crime, and intelligence powers.

Prior to joining the Department of Home Affairs, Anthony spent 15 years in the Commonwealth Attorney-General's Department in a range of roles focused on serious and organised crime and national security policy. During that time he was Australia's Head of Delegation to the Financial Action Task Force, and the OECD Working Group on Bribery. He holds a Bachelor of Arts (Hons) and Bachelor of Laws (Hons) from the Australian National University.
